**Directions to Emergency Veterinarian from the Show grounds:** Go East on M-50 to Telegraph Road. Turn left and follow Telegraph Road to I-275. Take I-275 North to Ann Arbor Road Exit. Turn left & proceed approximately 1/2 mile. The office is on the North side of the road just before Haggerty Road.

**DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE**

**From the East:** Exit I-75 at Dixie Hwy. (Exit 15). Go west to E. Elm Ave., turn right. Proceed on E. Elm Ave. to N. Monroe St., turn left. Go to W. Front St. Turn right W. Front St. becomes S. Custer (M-50). Take S. Custer to Fairgrounds.

**From the West:** US 23 to M-50 (Exit 17) Dundee (look for Cabela's). Go East to Fairgrounds on right.
